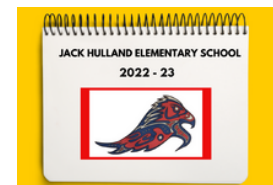

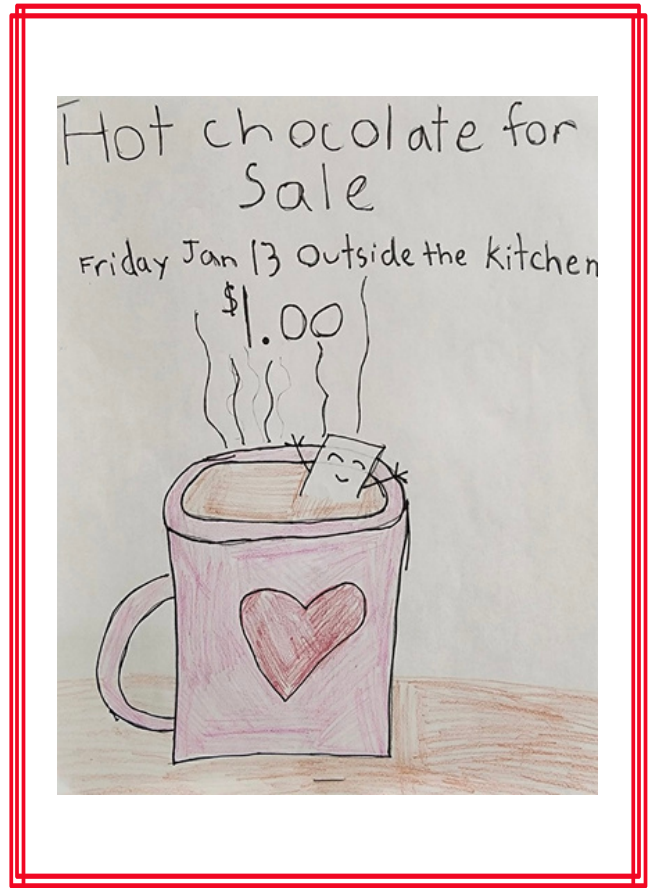

RESCUE CLUB

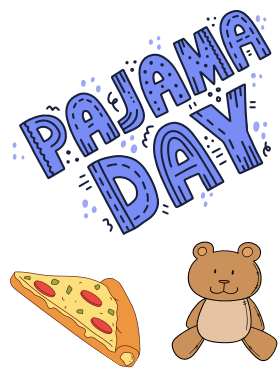
HOT CHOCOLATE SALE

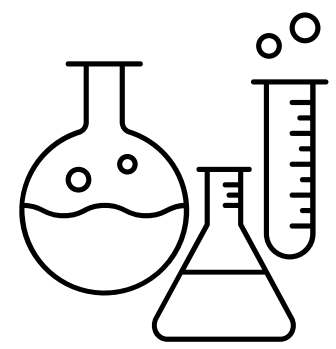
